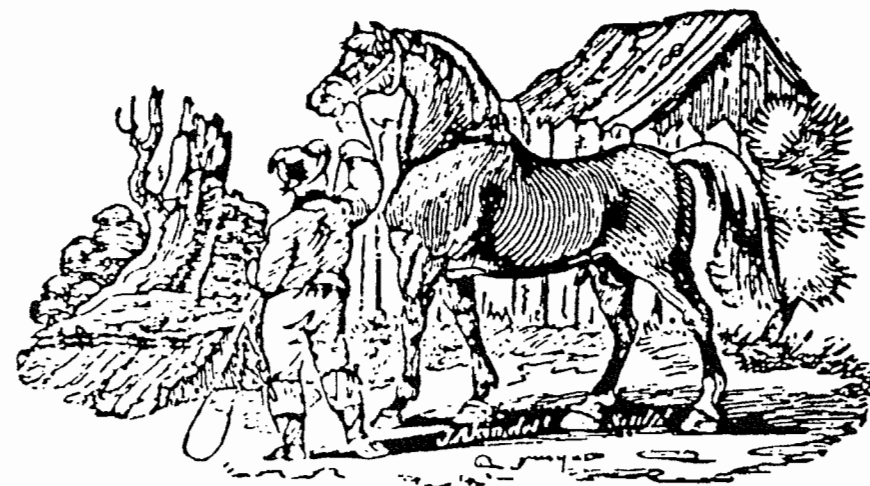

RULES & REGULATIONS

"Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications current USEF rule book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therein."

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

RESPONSIBILITY: Dunham Woods Farm, Wayne-DuPage Hunt or Dunham Woods Riding Club will not be held responsible for any accident to horses, property or any person on the grounds, nor will they be responsible for any property lost or destroyed. Each exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the management, executive committee, and Wayne-DuPage Hunt harmless from all claims and demands of any kind or nature arising from such exhibitor, his employees, animals or property exhibiting on or in the horse show grounds. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, limit entries, and cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages. Classes may be cancelled at the discretion of show management, or, if entries are not sufficient, management may combine into one competition. Classes may be cancelled if there are 4 or less entries - USEF divisions may be combined if there are 8 or less entries in either split section.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: All participants in this show as provided in USEF GR201 must present to the show secretary a current USEF membership card or a copy thereof. Nonmembers pay a USEF nonmember fee and a USHJA nonmember fee.

Horse ID Numbers: All horses competing in USEF licensed competitions must be properly identified and obtain a Horse ID Number from USEF.
USEF Rule GR1101

CREDENTIALS: All exhibitors must present the following credentials to the Show Secretary with the entry form: USEF Membership Card, Amateur Card (if you are a USEF amateur) and measurement cards for Ponies and Junior Hunters. NO NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION. All Ponies or Junior Horses that do not have a measurement card can be measured at a time and place to be announced.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS: Exhibitors cancelling entries in writing prior to first day of show, shall be entitled to a refund. After show begins, no refunds will be given without a Vet Certificate or, in case of rider, a Medical Certificate - no stall refund. There is a \$15.00 office charge for classes scratched.

for year end finals.



In order for riders to receive credit, they must be a current member. Membership is valid for the qualifying year and entitles a rider to show one or more horses in any of the accredited classes. Finals are held at the Pennsylvania National Horse Show. Members will receive newsletters with standings and upcoming events.

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses may not cross enter into the Amateur Owner Hunter Section at the same show. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any classes with fences over 3'3". Fences 2'9" to 3'3"; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Entries need not be jogged for soundness.

Opportunity classes are for entry level riders and are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and not required to pay USEF non-member, Federation or drug fees. Fences not to exceed 2'6" Rule GR821, GR407.1

Open to juniors who have not reached their 7th birthday and who are not entered in any other class in this show. To be shown in hand at a walk and to be judged on style, personality, with emphasis on confidence.

Entry Fee: \$35.00 Per Family

Open to two or more members of a family. to be shown abreast at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance as a group and horsemanship.

Open to all ages. To be shown both ways of the ring. To be judged on costume design and performance.

OUTSIDE COURSE WARMUP CLASS

Open to any horse or rider. No restrictions. Fences 2'6"

Any rider who has won two (2) IHJA Medals during the current show year may not participate in this Division for the balance or the current show year. All medal winners will automatically qualify for a final ride-off at a special show at the end of the season. A minimum of twenty (20) riders will be invited to participate in the final ride-off. Two or more tests for the top four contestants are required, USEF Hunter Seat Equitation Division tests 1-18. Only one rider per horse, a minimum of four (4) horses MUST BE ENTERED AND COMPETE in order to pin the class. Any rider who has won two (2) IHJA Medals during the current show year may not participate in this Division for the balance of the current show year. To be shown over a minimum of eight fences, set at 3' for riders 14 years and under and 3'6" for riders 15 years and over, with or without wings. Judge may require additional tests 1-19. Open to amateur members of the Wayne-DuPage Hunt over 18 years of age. Fences approximately 3'0". Horses may not cross-enter into Junior Member Division.

To be shown over a course with obstacles simulating those found in trappy hunting country, including opening gate. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on handyness and manners.

Formal hunt livery required. No exceptions are allowed. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on brilliance.

Class 63 Senior Members Hunters - UNDER SADDLE

To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited.

SENIOR MEMBERS HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP*The Persian Lamb Trophy***GENTLEMAN MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP**

To be awarded to the rider of the highest scoring horse ridden by a man in the Senior Members Hunter Division.

JUNIOR MEMBERS WORKING HUNTER

Open to members or children of members of the Wayne-DuPage Hunt or the Wayne-DuPage Hunt Pony Club who have not reached their 18th birthday. Manners and suitability shall be emphasized and extreme speed penalized in all classes. Fences approximately 3'. Horses may not cross-enter into Senior Member Division.

In classes over fences, the height and spread will be 2'3" for small ponies; 2'6" for medium ponies and 3' for large ponies. Pony measurement card required.

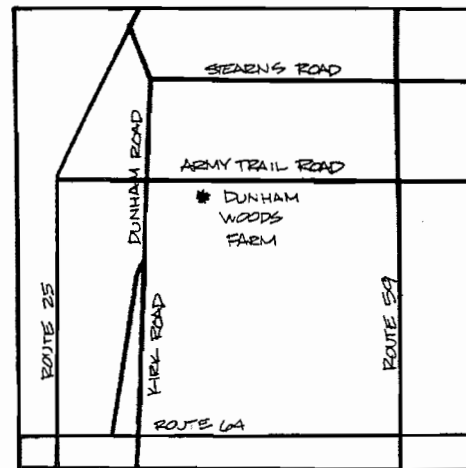
