Rules & Regulations:

Responsibility: Wayne Equestrian Center, Wayne-Dupage Hunt, Wayne Historical Preservation Society, Wayne Area Conservancy Foundation, or Dunham Woods Riding Club will not be held responsible for any accident to horses, property, or any person on the grounds, nor will they be responsible for any property lost or destroyed. Each exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the management, executive committee, Wayne Equestrian Center, Wayne Historical Preservation Society, Wayne Area Conservancy Foundation, Dunham Woods Riding Club and Wayne-DuPage Hunt harmless from all claims and demands of any kind or nature arising from such exhibitor, his employees, animals, or property exhibiting on or in the horse show grounds. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, limit entries, and cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages. Classes may be cancelled at the discretion of show management, or, if entries are not sufficient, management may combine into one competition. Classes may be combined if there are 3 or less entries.

Refunds and cancellations: Exhibitors cancelling entries in writing prior to the first day of show, shall be entitled to a refund. After show begins, no refunds will be given without a Vet Certificate, or, in case of rider, a Medical Certificate—no stall refunds. There is a \$15 office charge for classes scratched.

Schooling: Schooling permitted, weather permitting. Warm-up fences will be provided in schooling areas.

Parking: All cars will be parked east of the pole barn. Vans and trailers may be in the stabling area for unloading horses and equipment only. Please, no parking in the fire lane designated areas.

Tailgate Parking: A limited number of ringside parking spaces will be available on Sunday for \$40.00. One car per space.

Tailgate Picnic Award: Awarded on uniqueness, presentation, and gustatory merit appropriate to a day in country. Judging on Sunday 11:00 am to 11:30 am.

Rules & Regulations:

USEF Motorized Vehicle Statement

7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardians(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Stabling: Stabling is limited to 75 horses in 10 x 10 permanent wood stalls with metal gates.

Trailer in horses is available for a per horse fee.

Warm up area: Turf

Show Arena: Turf 300 x 125

Sand Ring: Sand 185 x 125

Protective Headgear: It is compulsory for all riders to wear ASTM, SEI helmets. See USEF Rule GR318. Any rider in violation of this rule will be prohibited from further riding until proper headgear is in place.

CLASS 90 WAYNE-DUPAGE HUNT JUMPER DERBY

William A. Muenzenmay Memorial Trophy

Class Entry Fee: Nominating Fee of \$150 and is due by noon on Sunday. Entry Fee is \$150. Post entry fee after noon on Sunday is \$25. Class will be run as a sweepstakes.

This class is open to all participants. The course will be run on the outside course and ring I. It will consist of 8-12 jumps with speed calculated at 382 yards per minute. In the event of a tie for first place, there will be a jump off.

FORMAL ATTIRE REQUIRED.

Fence Heights: 3' not to exceed 3'3"

Prize Money: Awarded 1st-6th Places

In order of placings: 30%,22%,16%,12%,10%,10%

Open to all levels of horse, pony, and rider. Fence height 2'9"

Open to two or more members of a family, to be shown abreast at a walk, trot, and canter in both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance as a group and horsemanship.

CLASS 73 COSTUME CLASS EXHIBITION

Class Entry Fee: \$25/Participant

Open to all ages. To be shown both ways of the ring. To be judge on costume design and performance. **MAXIMUM 4 horses per group. **HARD HATS REQUIRED****

CLASS 78 HUNT TEAMS

Class Entry Fee: \$45 per team

The St. James Farm Perpetual Trophy

Teams of three hunters (to include at least one adult rider) to be shown tandem in hunting attire over outside course with fences approximately 2'6." Combined ownership permitted. To be judged on performance as a team. Also judged on soundness 85%, resemblance 15%. Appointments not to count.

CLASS 80 SILVER FOX CHALLENGE

Class Entry Fee: \$25

Flat class for those riders who are 50 and older. May require opening and shutting a gate, or mounting/dismounting. To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited.

CLASS 81 OPEN CLASS

Class Entry Fee: \$25

Open to all riding disciplines (i.e. Western, English, side saddle, etc.). To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited.

JUNIOR MEMBERS WORKING HUNTER SECTION

Open to members or children of members who are in good standing with a recognized hunt or pony club, who have not reached their 18th birthday. Manners and suitability shall be emphasized and extreme speed penalized in all classes. **Fences approximately 2' 6."**

Individual Class: \$35 Section Entry: \$85

CLASS 68 JUNIOR MEMBERS HANDY HUNTER

To be shown over a course with obstacles simulating those found in trappy hunting country. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on handiness and manners.

CLASS 69 JUNIOR MEMBERS HUNTER, HUNTING ATTIRE

To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on brilliance.

CLASS 70 JUNIOR MEMBERS HUNTER U/S

To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited.

To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales prohibited.

Open to amateur members who are in good standing with a recognized hunt. **Ages 18 & over. Fences approximately 2' 6"**

CLASS 65 SENIOR MEMBERS HANDY HUNTER O/F

To be shown over a course with obstacles simulating those found in trappy hunting country, including opening a gate. To be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on handiness and manners.

CLASS 66 SENIOR MEMBERS HUNTER, HUNTING ATTIRE

The George R. Wood Memorial Trophy
Formal hunt livery required. No exceptions are allowed. To be judge on performance and soundness with an emphasis on brilliance.

CLASS 67 SENIOR MEMBERS HUNTER U/S

To be judged on performance and soundness at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.
